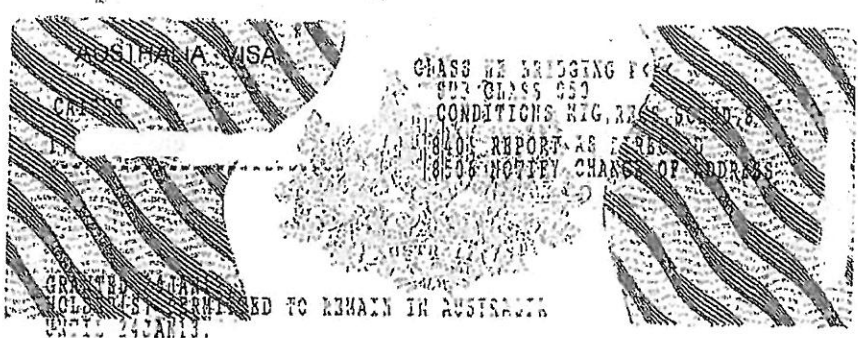

Does a client need a visa label?

Australia's modern electronic visa system does not require a client to have a visa label placed in their passport to confirm their immigration status and entitlements in Australia. Their visa information is held electronically and you can access it at any time, with the client's permission once they have registered, using the Visa Entitlement Verification On-line (VEVO) system.

VEVO is a free internet service available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It allows you to view the client's visa details on-line and it provides greater detail about their visa than on a label. You can see all the relevant details, for which the client has given permission, of their current visa, including subclass, visa description, grant date, period of stay, grant number, entries allowed and condition that apply to your visa.
